Each of the undersigned members of the Canvass Board of the Bachelor Gulch Metropolitan District certifies that the following is a true and correct abstract of the votes cast at the special election Of the Bachelor Gulch Metropolitan District, at which time the eligible electors of the Bachelor Gulch Metropolitan District voted as indicated on the attached Judges' Certificate of Election Returns.

The votes cast for and against each ballot issue and ballot question submitted were as follows:

**BALLOT ISSUE 5A:**

SHALL BACHELOR GULCH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$3,000,000 ANNUALLY IN 2011 AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY THE IMPOSITION PURSUANT TO SECTION 32-1-1106, C.R.S., OF A SALES TAX OF NO MORE THAN 5.0% (AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS) FOR THE PURPOSES OF FINANCING, CONSTRUCTING, OPERATING AND MAINTAINING STREETS, SAFETY PROTECTION AND TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS; SUCH SALES TAX TO BE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER TAXES LEVIED BY THE DISTRICT; AND SHALL THE DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH SALES TAX AND ALL OTHER AMOUNTS RECEIVED ANNUALLY FROM ANY REVENUE SOURCES WHATSOEVER AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION AND ANY OTHER LAW?

**PROCEDURAL INSTRUCTIONS:** The canvassers meet to survey the returns and certify the results. They do not recount the ballots, unless there is a formal recount. No later than seven days after the election, the canvass board shall certify the official abstract of votes cast which the DEO uses to certify the election (results). This form must be filed with the Division of Local Government within 30 days after the election and must be posted in the office of the DEO. The DEO shall notify the candidates of their election; after the oath and bond are filed, the DEO shall make and deliver a formal certificate to the elected directors.
