

Each of the undersigned members of the Canvass Board of the Greenwood Metropolitan District certifies that the following is a true and correct abstract of the votes cast at the special election of the Greenwood Metropolitan District held on November 2, 2010, at which time the eligible electors of the District voted as indicated on the attached Judge's Certificate of Election Returns. The votes cast for and against each ballot issue submitted were as follows:



JUDGES' CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION RETURNS AND STATEMENT

NOVEMBER 2, 2010 SPECIAL ELECTION**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED by the undersigned who conducted the election held by the Greenwood Metropolitan District on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 2010, by mail ballot, that, after subscribing and swearing to the oath of office, they opened the ballot depository/walk-in voting location at 1700 Lincoln Street, Suite 3800, Denver, Colorado, at 8:00 a.m. on October 12, 2010, and kept said ballot depository/walk-in voting location open between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. every business day through November 1, 2010, and on November 2, 2010, election day, the hours were extended from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for receipt of ballots and walk-in voting, after which time they counted the ballots cast; and

That the votes cast on ballot issues to implement the provisions of Section 20 of Article X of the Colorado Constitution as applied to the District were as follows:

GREENWOOD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT BALLOT ISSUE NO. 5A:

"SHALL GREENWOOD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$1,500,000 ANNUALLY (FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR DOLLAR INCREASE) AND BY THE SAME AMOUNT RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER PLUS INFLATION AND LOCAL GROWTH; SUCH TAX INCREASE TO BE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER TAXES OF THE DISTRICT AND TO CONSIST OF AN AD VALOREM MILL LEVY IMPOSED ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT, WITHOUT LIMITATION OF RATE OR WITH SUCH LIMITATIONS AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DISTRICT, AND IN AMOUNTS SUFFICIENT TO PRODUCE THE ANNUAL INCREASE SET FORTH ABOVE OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING EXPENSES RELATED TO ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE OF THE DISTRICT; AND SHALL SUCH TAX REVENUES AND INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON BE COLLECTED, RETAINED, AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE IN 2010 AND IN EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, SECTION 29-1-301, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, OR ANY OTHER LAW?"


