


SHALL INVERNESS METROPOLITAN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, ARAPAHOE AND DOUGLAS COUNTIES, COLORADO, DEBT BE INCREASED IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000,000 WITH AN ANNUAL REPAYMENT COST NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000 AND A TOTAL REPAYMENT COST NOT TO EXCEED \$6,000,000, BY THE ISSUANCE OF ITS GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR OTHER MULTIPLE FISCAL YEAR OBLIGATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING ALL OR ANY PART OF THE COSTS OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR MONUMENT SIGNS, BUILDING IDENTIFICATION SIGNS, WAYFINDING AND DIRECTIONAL SIGNS, BUS STOPS AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS, UPGRADING AND OTHER APPURTENANT IMPROVEMENTS; AND SHALL THE MILL LEVY BE INCREASED IN ANY YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION OF RATE AND IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM, IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT OR ANY REFUNDING DEBT (OR TO CREATE A RESERVE FOR SUCH PAYMENT); AND SHALL SUCH DEBT BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 5.5 PERCENT (5.5%) AND WITH A MATURITY DATE NOT TO EXCEED 15 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE, SUCH BONDS TO BE ISSUED, DATED AND SOLD AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES AND IN SUCH MANNER AND TO CONTAIN SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, AS THE DISTRICT MAY DETERMINE, WHICH AUTHORIZATION SHALL INCLUDE AUTHORIZATION TO REFUND SUCH BONDS OR OBLIGATIONS AND ANY REFUNDING BONDS OR OBLIGATIONS AT A LOWER RATE WITHOUT ADDITIONAL VOTER APPROVAL; AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH BONDS AND REFUNDING BONDS AND THE REVENUES PLEDGED AS SECURITY THEREFORE AND ANY EARNINGS FROM THE INVESTMENT OF SUCH PROCEEDS AND REVENUES BE COLLECTED AND SPENT WITHOUT LIMITATION OR CONDITION, AND WITHOUT LIMITING THE COLLECTION OR SPENDING OR ANY OTHER REVENUES OR FUNDS BY THE DISTRICT, UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED by the undersigned, who conducted the election held in the Inverness Metropolitan Improvement District, in Arapahoe and Douglas Counties, Colorado, on the 1st day of November, 2011, that after qualifying by swearing and subscribing to their Oaths of Office, they opened the polls at 7:00 a.m., and that they kept the polls open continuously until the hour of 7:00 p.m. on said date, after which they counted the ballots cast for any ballot issues and ballot questions duly submitted,

The votes cast for and against the ballot issue and ballot question submitted were as follows:

SHALL INVERNESS METROPOLITAN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, ARAPAHOE AND DOUGLAS COUNTIES, COLORADO, DEBT BE INCREASED IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000,000 WITH AN ANNUAL REPAYMENT COST NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000 AND A TOTAL REPAYMENT COST NOT TO EXCEED \$6,000,000, BY THE ISSUANCE OF ITS GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR OTHER MULTIPLE FISCAL YEAR OBLIGATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING ALL OR ANY PART OF THE COSTS OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR MONUMENT SIGNS, BUILDING IDENTIFICATION SIGNS, WAYFINDING AND DIRECTIONAL SIGNS, BUS STOPS AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS, UPGRADING AND OTHER APPURTENANT IMPROVEMENTS; AND SHALL THE MILL LEVY BE INCREASED IN ANY YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION OF RATE AND IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM, IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT OR ANY REFUNDING DEBT (OR TO CREATE A RESERVE FOR SUCH PAYMENT); AND SHALL SUCH DEBT BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 5.5 PERCENT (5.5%) AND WITH A MATURITY DATE NOT TO EXCEED 15 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUANCE, SUCH BONDS TO BE ISSUED, DATED AND SOLD AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES AND IN SUCH MANNER AND TO CONTAIN SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT HERewith, AS THE DISTRICT MAY DETERMINE, WHICH AUTHORIZATION SHALL INCLUDE AUTHORIZATION TO REFUND SUCH BONDS OR OBLIGATIONS AND ANY REFUNDING BONDS OR OBLIGATIONS AT A LOWER RATE WITHOUT ADDITIONAL VOTER APPROVAL; AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH BONDS AND REFUNDING BONDS AND THE REVENUES PLEDGED AS SECURITY THEREFORE AND ANY EARNINGS FROM THE INVESTMENT OF SUCH PROCEEDS AND REVENUES BE COLLECTED AND SPENT WITHOUT LIMITATION OR CONDITION, AND WITHOUT LIMITING THE COLLECTION OR SPENDING OR ANY OTHER REVENUES OR FUNDS BY THE DISTRICT, UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?
