**RESOLUTION  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
ARVADA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

A RESOLUTION (1) AUTHORIZING A POLLING PLACE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 8, 2012; (2) APPOINTING A DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL; AND (3) DESIGNATING THE POLLING LOCATION

WHEREAS, the Arvada Fire Protection District ("District") is a political subdivision of the State of Colorado, formed pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-101, *et seq.* ("Act") to provide fire and emergency medical services to the citizens and property within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-1-805(1), the District is required to hold regular elections on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of May in every even-numbered year to fill Director positions that have become vacant through expiration of the term of office or otherwise. Accordingly, the District is required to hold an election on May 8, 2012 ("Election");

WHEREAS, by law, the terms of office of Directors James H. Snyder and Edward G. Terranova shall expire after their successors are elected to those positions during the Election and take office;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Uniform Election Code of 1992 ("Code"), the Election must be conducted to elect two (2) eligible individuals to fill the positions currently held by Directors Snyder and Terranova, which elected individuals will then serve for a term of four (4) years each;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Code, the District may conduct the Election as a polling place election; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set forth certain procedures concerning the conduct of the Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Arvada Fire Protection District in the County of Jefferson, State of Colorado that:

1. A polling place election shall be held on May 8, 2012, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. pursuant to and in accordance with the Act, Code, and other applicable laws. At that time, two (2) Directors will be elected to serve a term of four years each.
2. There shall be one election precinct for the convenience of the eligible electors of the District, the boundaries of which shall be identical to the boundaries of the District, and there shall be one polling place at the following location:



situated in the County of Jefferson, State of Colorado. The polling place located at the above address shall also be the polling place for disabled electors and for eligible electors not residing within the District.

3. The Board of Directors hereby designates Jennifer Enochs as the Designated Election Official of the District, who is hereby authorized and directed to take any action necessary or appropriate for the conduct of the Election. The Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Act, Code, TABOR and other applicable laws.
4. Applications for mail-in ballots may be filed with the Designated Election Official at the above address no later than the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on the 7th day prior to the election (Tuesday, May 1, 2012), if the mail-in ballot is to be mailed to the elector, or until the close of business on the Friday immediately preceding the election (Friday, May 4, 2012), if the mail-in ballot will not be mailed to the elector.
5. Self-Nomination and Acceptance forms are available at the Designated Election Official's office located at the above address. In order to be a candidate for one of the director positions, a qualified individual must file a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form with the Designated Election Official no later than the close of business on Friday, March 2, 2012.
6. If the only matter before the electors is the election of Directors of the District and if, at the close of business on March 6, 2012, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the Election, including candidates timely filing affidavits of intent no later than the close of business on March 5, 2012, the Designated Election Official shall cancel the Election and declare the candidates elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published and posted in accordance with the Code.
7. If any part or provision of this Resolution is adjudged to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Resolution, it being the Board's intention that the various provisions hereof are severable.
8. All prior actions of District, the Board, or the District's members and officers directed toward the Election and the objects and purposes herein, which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution, are ratified, approved, and confirmed. Unless otherwise defined herein, all terms in this Resolution have the meanings specified in the Code.
9. All prior acts, orders, and resolutions, or parts thereof, of the Board which are inconsistent or in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.
10. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately.


