

APPOINTING A DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL AND
AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL
TO CANCEL ELECTION**

32-1-804(2), 1-1-111(2), 1-5-208(1.5), C.R.S.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 32-1-804(2), C.R.S., the Board of Directors of the HOEHNE FIRE PROTECTION District, LAS ANIMAS County, Colorado is authorized to designate a Designated Election Official to exercise the authority of the Board in conducting the election, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 1-5-208, C.R.S., the Board can authorize the Designated Election Official to cancel the election upon certain conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the HOEHNE FIRE PROTECTION District, LAS ANIMAS County, Colorado that:
