SHALL JACKSON 105 FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT'S TAXES BE INCREASED \$46,009 ANNUALLY IN 2013, AND BY SUCH AMOUNT AS MAY BE RAISED ANNUALLY IN EACH YEAR THEREAFTER BY THE IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX RATE OF UP TO 1.11 MILL, RESULTING IN A TOTAL DISTRICT PROPERTY TAX RATE, EXCLUSIVE OF REFUNDS, ABATEMENTS, OR DEBT SERVICE, NOT TO EXCEED 8.11 MILLS, AND SUFFICIENT TO GENERATE AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE 2011 GENERAL PROPERTY TAX REVENUES, ADJUSTED ANNUALLY FOR INFLATION AND LOCAL GROWTH (AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION) TO PAY DISTRICT OPERATING EXPENSES; AND SHALL THE DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH ADDITIONAL PROPERTY TAX RATE AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S., OR ANY OTHER LAW?






