

Ballot Issue/Ballot Question:
Ballot issues referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot issues initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot issue listed as an 'amendment' proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot issue listed as a 'proposition' proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A 'yes' vote on any ballot issue is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a 'no' vote on any ballot issue is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

WESTERN RIO BLANCO METROPOLITAN RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT QUESTION A:
SHALL THE WESTERN RIO BLANCO METROPOLITAN PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED APPROXIMATELY \$320,518.77 ANNUALLY (ESTIMATED FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR DOLLAR INCREASE), AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, BY INCREASING THE MILL LEVY OF THE WESTERN RIO BLANCO METROPOLITAN RECREATION & PARK DISTRICT BY 0.75 MILLS (FROM 4.0 MILLS TO 4.75 MILLS), BEGINNING IN TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2012 AND CONTINUING THROUGH AND ENDING WITH TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2016, FOR THE DEDICATED PURPOSE OF SUPPLEMENTING THE REVENUES OF THE RANGELY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-4 FOR CERTAIN "ACTIVITIES," DEFINED AS INTERSCHOLASTIC SCHOOL ATHLETICS AND OTHER SCHOOL RECREATIONAL PURPOSES AS BUDGETING PERMITS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GAME AND RECREATIONAL CLUBS (E.G., CHESS CLUB; MATH CLUB) AND FFA, AND SHALL THE TAX REVENUES FROM SUCH MILL LEVY INCREASE (REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH REVENUES IN ANY YEAR AFTER THE FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR EXCEED THE ESTIMATED DOLLAR AMOUNT STATED ABOVE), AND ALL INVESTMENT INCOME ON ALL SUCH TAX REVENUES, CONSTITUTE VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED AND SPENT NOTWITHSTANDING THE LIMITATIONS THAT WOULD OTHERWISE APPLY UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?
