No later than seventeen (17) days after the election, the canvass board shall certify the official abstract of votes cast which the DEO uses to certify the election (results). This form must be filed with the Division of Local Government within 30 days after the election and must be posted in the office of the DEO. The DEO shall notify the candidates of their election; after the oath and bond are filed, the DEO shall make and deliver a formal certificate to the elected directors.


