Said District shall be a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado with all the powers thereof. The facilities, services, programs, and financial arrangements of the District shall conform as far as practicable to the approved Service Plan and



Resolution of the City Council of the City of Castle Pines, Colorado approving the Service Plan for the North Pine Vistas Metropolitan District No. 3. The approved Service Plan and Resolution of Approval required by Title 32, Article 1, Part 2, Colorado Revised Statutes, as amended, previously filed in the within action shall be and the same are hereby incorporated by reference in this Order, and may be amended in the future as provided by law.

In accordance with Section 32-1-305.5(5), C.R.S., and under the authority of the Clerk of the Court, the Designated Election Official shall issue certificates of election for the directors elected.

The Court finds that the ballot questions and ballot issues set forth above passed.

The District consists of approximately 238 acres and is located entirely within the City of Castle Pines, Douglas County, Colorado, as more particularly described as follows:


