In all cases the totals were always 1 off. In observing the process, the Canvass Board felt the errors had to have been made in the hand-tallying due to the number of issues and ballots that had to be dealt with. We ended up having to pull 355 ballots. Out of the 28 issues on our ballot, for some reason this year we had to count them all except, I believe 3. This process took over 8 hours. My judges are veteran judges and one is even an accountant. It was quite the process this year. I support the post audit but to have to do this many issues was just overkill in my opinion. I understand that does not matter but it was really the longest process we have ever worked.

I do appreciate you allowing us to change the machine we used. The one we started with kept jamming and the second one wasn't so bad.
