Elections Canvass Committee

Review of my post-election audit for the 2014 Mineral County General Election reveals a few very minor discrepancies. My canvass board including myself feel confident that these additional votes counted during a hand count were due to three ballots in particular that showed very incomplete "marks." These marks, per say, were single lines drawn through the ovals beside various candidates and very likely were not counted by the optical scanner. The ballot was counted, the credits to candidates were not, even though intention was clear upon human inspection. We have no way to know if the machine counted the marks as it is not a cumulative credit count. There are very clear instructions to the voter to completely fill in the oval, these three ballots were hardly marked. My judges chose to honor their intentions and the outcomes made no difference in each contested race. I intend to advertise more instruction on filling ovals previous to any future election and hope those three individuals take more care to make sure their vote credits their intended candidates.
