





Post-Audit Overview

The results of the Post Audit for the November 3, 2015 Coordinated Election showed a difference of one vote in two races.

The first difference appeared in the Pueblo School District No. 60 Director At Large race. This difference was explainable by a mark on a ballot in the target area of the said race that appeared to be the result of a pen mark bleeding from another mark when the ballot was folded.

The second difference appeared in the City of Pueblo Civil Service Commissioner race. This difference was not clearly evident as to the reason for the difference. The hand tallies were check several times for correctness, and they were found to be correct; having one vote over the machine count. The batch of ballots in question was re-tallied on the 400C, still resulting in a difference in the tallies. The ballots showing a vote in the race were ran on the 400C, one at a time in an attempt to pin point the exact ballot affecting the tally. When running the ballots one at a time, each ballot showed a vote in the race; which would show an equal hand tally and machine tally. The tallies were recorded as being one off because both times the whole batch of ballots was run through the 400C, the tally in this race was not equal to the hand tally.
