
The Canvass Board met Friday, July 8, 2016, and conducted both a hand tally and machine tally for the races selected by the State of Colorado Secretary of State's office for certification purposes of the 2016 Primary Election. Upon conducting the hand tally, the Republican candidate Mark Arndt, indicated a total of 62 votes cast with the machine tally indicating a total of 61 votes cast. At this time, staff reset the eScan and all ballots were physically reviewed and one ballot was questioned as to whether or not it had been marked appropriately to have been read by the eScan in the targeted area. This ballot was then processed as an individual scanned ballot at which time the race for Mark Arndt read as "0". See attached copy of ballot.

It was decided by all Canvass Board members to utilize a separate eScan to verify if this ballot would read the same. Staff reset the second eScan and the ballot was again scanned with the race for Mark Arndt again reading "0".


It appears that in central processing, this ballot was thought to have been appropriately marked for scanning, and in fact, it may have been necessary to have duplicated the ballot which did not occur. Upon further discussion with the Canvass Board, it was determined to accept the machine count and hand tally count in this race as sufficient.

A copy of the tally tape from all readings has been attached for review.




