
As you know, this law firm represents Myriah Sullivan Conroy and Jeffrey Sherman with respect to various changes and proposed changes to the Colorado Election Rules related specifically to Direct Electronic Voting Machines (“DREs”).

We reviewed the Request for Proposals to select vendors for the Uniform Voting System. We appreciate and encourage the way in which the Request for Proposals appears to contemplate a drastic reduction in the use of DREs in Colorado. Although our comments are general in nature, we have submitted a copy of this letter to the email repository for comments to the Request for Proposals: publicparticipationpanel@sos.state.co.us.

As we previously stated, we intend to participate fully in the public comment period for the recodification of the Election Rules for the purpose of achieving the same goal: drastic reduction or elimination of DRE usage in the state of Colorado due to DREs’ unreliable track record and their vulnerability to hacking.

To the extent that we have substantive comments for the consideration of the Secretary of State’s Office, we will submit them during that process. We look forward to working with you and the Secretary of State’s Office as the recodification process progresses to ensure increased DRE security and to work toward the goal of limited use and elimination of DREs in Colorado elections.
