

ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS	

Counsel for Complainant filed herein an Administrative Complaint and a Motion to Stay the proceedings, both of which are dated January 29, 2024. The Motion to Stay asserts that the parties have agreed to a settlement and have submitted it to the Deputy Secretary of State for approval. I find that there is “good cause” for a continuance of thirty days, as allowed by § 1-45-111.7(6)(a), C.R.S., to finalize settlement of the case. Campaign & Political Finance Rule 24.5.1, 8 Code Colo. Regs. 1505-6.

The Motion to Stay is GRANTED. This matter is stayed for thirty days, pending finalization of the settlement agreement. If no settlement is approved by the Deputy Secretary, Respondent AT&T Colorado Employee PAC is ordered on or before February 27, 2024 to file an Answer to the January 29, 2024 Administrative Complaint.
