

ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS	

Counsel for Complainant filed herein an Administrative Complaint and a Motion to Stay the proceedings, both of which are dated February 12, 2024. The Motion to Stay asserts that the parties have agreed to a settlement in principle and need more time to finalize the agreement. I find that there is “good cause” for a continuance of thirty days, as allowed by § 1-45-111.7(6)(a), C.R.S., to finalize settlement of the case. Campaign & Political Finance Rule 24.5.1, 8 Code Colo. Regs. 1505-6.

The Motion to Stay is GRANTED. This matter is stayed for thirty days, pending finalization of the settlement agreement. If no settlement is reached, Respondent JB Moss Voice of the Electorate (Vote) is ordered on or before March 13, 2024 to file an Answer to the February 12, 2024 Administrative Complaint.
