

| ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS | |

Today, counsel for Complainant filed herein both a Complaint and a Motion to Stay the proceedings. The Motion to Stay asserts that the parties are engaged in good faith negotiation on the terms of a settlement agreement to resolve the allegations in the Division's Complaint. I find that there is "good cause" for a continuance of thirty days, as allowed by § 1-45-111.7(6)(a), C.R.S., to finalize settlement of the case. Campaign & Political Finance Rule 24.5.1, 8 Code Colo. Regs. 1505-6.

The Motion to Stay is GRANTED. This matter is stayed for thirty days, pending finalization of the settlement agreement. If no settlement is reached, Respondent RESIGN DPS BOARD is ordered on or before March 13, 2024 to file an Answer to the February 23, 2024 Administrative Complaint.
