

RESOLUTION 95-G-3

RESOLUTION FOR SAGUACHE COUNTY TO PERFORM MAINTENANCE WORK ON STREETS IN THE TOWN OF BONANZA IN EXCHANGE FOR THE HUTF REVENUE OF THE TOWN.

WHEREAS, The Town of Bonanza has streets which require maintenance, and;

WHEREAS, The Town of Bonanza receives funds from the State Highway Users Tax Fund (HUTF), and;

WHEREAS, The Town of Bonanza has no equipment to maintain its streets, and the amount of money provided by HUTF revenues is not enough to purchase or lease appropriate equipment, and;

WHEREAS, There is no private enterprise in the vicinity which is capable of performing the maintenance work for the amount of money that is available to the Town, and;

WHEREAS, Saguache County has equipment for road maintenance which is used in the vicinity by the County to maintain County Roads, and;

WHEREAS, Saguache County is willing to perform the needed street maintenance for the Town of Bonanza in exchange for the HUTF revenue which is available to the Town.

THEREFORE, if is resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Saguache and by the Town of Bonanza that effective January 1, 1995 and continuing until sixty days after notice by either party to cancel it:

that this Resolution shall constitute an agreement between the County of Saguache and the Town of Bonanza upon execution of the same by both parties;

that the Town of Bonanza will execute such further documents as are necessary to transfer to Saguache County all revenue from the Highway Users Tax Fund for which the Town is eligible;

that Saguache County will maintain the streets of the Town of Bonanza in like manner as it maintains county roads as follows:

Main Street between the Town limits 1.4 miles; First Avenue eastward from Main Street 0.73 miles; and Second Street from First Avenue southward 0.45 miles; the length of maintenance on each street to be adjusted to provide maintenance on streets on which residents are living a significant portion of the year.

that Saguache County will provide routine maintenance and repair of the streets to include blading, grading, pot-hole filling and snow removal, such maintenance to be sufficient to assure that the streets are passable to single-axel-drive automobiles. Saguache County will not be responsible for any utility placement in the streets, either to provide trenches or to repair the streets after utility placement.

that Saguache County will not be required to pave or repave, construct or reconstruct any streets under this agreement. The parties may agree separately concerning street paving, repaving, construction or reconstruction.

It is agreed that either party may cancel this agreement upon 60-days written notice to the other party.






## CERTIFICATION OF AUTHORITY


