



FINAL STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY
Petition to Recall Senator John Morse
State Senate, District 11

July 5, 2013

On June 3, 2013, the proponents of the petition to recall Senator John Morse submitted 16,198 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. To be deemed sufficient, the petition must contain at least 7,178 valid signatures.¹

Petition verification summary:

Total number of qualified signature lines	16,198
Total number of entries rejected (invalid)	6,061
Total number of withdrawn signatures	121
Total number of entries accepted (valid)	10,016
Number of valid signatures required	7,178

Because it contains more than enough valid signatures, the petition is sufficient.

A record of all accepted and rejected signatures—including reasons for each rejection—is on file with the Secretary of State.
