Re: Senate District 3 recall petition – certificate of sufficiency

Dear Governor Hickenlooper:

On June 10, 2013, proponents of a petition to recall Senator Angela Giron from State Senate District 3 filed their petition with the Secretary of State. On June 24, the Secretary of State issued a statement of sufficiency, declaring that the proponents gathered more than enough valid signatures to cause a recall election in Senate District 3.

On June 25, an elector from Senate District 3 filed a protest challenging the sufficiency of the recall petition. The Secretary of State held a protest hearing on July 3 and issued a ruling upholding the sufficiency of the petition on July 9. Our office received no further protests as of the expiration of the protest filing deadline on July 9.

Under Article XXI, Section 2 of the Colorado Constitution, I am submitting the final statement of sufficiency, along with a complete copy of the recall petition to you, so that you may set the recall election date.
