



STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY
SB19-042 Referendum "National Popular Vote"

August 29, 2019

On August 1, 2019, the proponents and designated representatives of the Referendum on Senate Bill 19-042 ("National Popular Vote") submitted 228,832 petition signatures to the Secretary of State's office. After reviewing a five-percent random sample of the submitted signatures, the Secretary of State's office projected the number of valid signatures to be greater than 110 percent of the total number of signatures required for placement on the ballot.

Random sample verification summary:

Total number of qualified signatures submitted	228,832
5% of qualified signatures submitted (random sample)	11,442
Total number of entries accepted (valid) from the random sample	9,184
Total number of entries rejected (invalid) from the random sample	2,258
Number of projected valid signatures from the random sample	183,673
Total number of signatures required for placement on ballot	124,632
Projected percentage of required valid signatures	147.37%

Because the random sample verification established that the projected number of valid signatures totals 147.37 percent of the amount required for placement on the ballot, the SB19-042 Referendum is sufficient and will be certified to the 2020 general election ballot.
