**STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY**

March 24, 2020

On March 9, 2020, Dave Gross, Democratic candidate for University of Colorado Regent for the 2nd Congressional District, submitted 1,819 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 30, 2020 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Gross's petition must contain at least 1,500 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State has determined that Mr. Gross submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 Democratic Party primary election ballot. <sup>1</sup> Under section 1-4-801(2)(a.5), C.R.S., a major party member of the board of regents for the university of Colorado for a congressional district candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand five hundred signers or signers equal to ten percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . . ."
