STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

April 15, 2020

On March 17, 2020, Democratic U.S. Senate candidate Michelle Ferrigno Warren submitted 8,378 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 30, 2020 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Warren's petition must contain at least 1,500 valid signatures from each of Colorado's seven congressional districts, for a total of at least 10,500 valid signatures statewide.¹

¹ Under section 1-4-801(2)(c)(II), C.R.S., a major party statewide candidate petition requires signatures from "at least one thousand five hundred eligible electors in each congressional district"

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State has determined that Ms. Warren submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 primary election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures, including reasons for each rejection, is on file with the Secretary of State.

Note: This insufficiency statement may be updated if Ms. Warren submits petition signature cure affidavits to the Elections Division that cures any of the 35 signature mismatches found on her petition and provided to her campaign on April 15. These cures must be submitted to the Elections Division by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 20.
