On July 27, 2020, Alex Johnson, an unaffiliated candidate for U.S. House District 2, submitted 395 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 3, 2020, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Johnson's petition must contain at least 1,500 valid signatures.¹
