**STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY**

August 17, 2020

On July 27, 2020, Tami Young, a nonpartisan candidate for Regional Transportation District Board of Directors, District M, submitted 273 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 3, 2020, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Young's petition must contain at least 250 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Ms. Young submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 general election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.
