STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

August 17, 2020

On July 27, 2020, Tami Young, a nonpartisan candidate for Regional Transportation District Board of Directors, District M, submitted 273 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 3, 2020, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Young's petition must contain at least 250 valid signatures.¹
