

## Statement of Sufficiency

2021-2022 Proposed Initiative \#27 "Property Tax Assessment Rate Reduction"
August 26, 2021

On August 2, 2021, the proponents and designated representatives of 2021-2022 Proposed Initiative \#27 ("Property Tax Assessment Rate Reduction") submitted 192,562 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. After reviewing a fivepercent random sample of the submitted signatures, the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office projected the number of valid signatures to be greater than 110 percent of the total number of signatures required for placement on the ballot.

## Random sample verification summary:

Because the random sample verification established that the projected number of valid signatures totals 111.18 percent of the amount required for placement on the ballot, 2021-2022 Proposed Initiative \#27 is sufficient and will be certified to the 2021 coordinated election ballot.
