STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

2021-2022 Proposed Initiative #58 "Access to Natural Medicine"

July 21, 2022

On June 27, 2022, the proponents and designated representatives of 2021-2022 Proposed Initiative #58 ("Access to Natural Medicine") submitted 225,140 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. After reviewing a five-percent random sample of the submitted signatures, the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office projected the number of valid signatures to be greater than 110 percent of the total number of signatures required for placement on the ballot.

Random sample verification summary:

Total number of entries accepted (valid) from the random sample	6,938
Total number of entries rejected (invalid) from the random sample	4,319
Number of projected valid signatures from the random sample	138,760
Total number of signatures required for placement on ballot	124,632
Projected percentage of required valid signatures	111.34%

Because the random sample verification established that the projected number of valid signatures totals 111.34 percent of the amount required for placement on the ballot, 2021-2022 Proposed Initiative #58 is sufficient and will be certified to the 2022 general election ballot.
