



## STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

August 1, 2022

On July 14, 2022, Ian Harwick, a nonpartisan candidate for Regional Transportation District Board of Directors, District L, submitted 282 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 8, 2022, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Harwick's petition must contain at least 250 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>

### Petition Verification Summary:

Number of valid signatures required	250

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Mr. Harwick submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2022 general election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.
