



STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

August 1, 2022

On July 14, 2022, Tim Long, Colorado Center Party candidate for United States House of Representatives, District 8, submitted 1,008 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 8, 2022 general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Long's petition must contain at least 1,500 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

Number of qualified signatures submitted	1,725
Number of entries rejected	717
Number of entries accepted	1,008
Number of valid signatures required	1,500

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Mr. Long submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2022 general election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

¹ Under section 1-4-802 (1)(c)(III), C.R.S., an unaffiliated congressional candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand five hundred signers or signers equal to two and one-half percent of the votes cast in the congressional district in the most recent general election . . ."
