



STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

April 19, 2024

On March 19, 2024, Lisi Owen, Democratic candidate for District Attorney for the 2nd Judicial District, submitted 1,060 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 25, 2024 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Owen's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

Number of valid signatures required	1,000

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Ms. Owen submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2024 Democratic Party primary election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

¹ Under section 1-4-801(2)(b.5), C.R.S., a major party district attorney candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand signers or signers equal to ten percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated"
