I know this isn't really the crux of the new rusles, but I would like to comment that it would be so helpful if you would raise the threshold to report to match the IRS's 990N limit of \$50,000. I help all the PTAs in the Jefferson County Public School system and if you are a Title I school and your PTA runs a fundraiser selling, say cookie dough, the fundraising company gets 50-60% of the proceeds so you can sell \$25,000 of cookie dough and only receive \$10,000 in actual proceeds and you have to file with the SOS, but you get to do the nice epostcard with the IRS. It would be really helpful if the state had a similar reporting limit ...OR...a similar epostcard type of reporting for smaller nonprofits like the IRS does.


