Re: Comments on new rules

Rule 8.4.3 - I think this rule needs to be clarified. I interpret it as saying that we can conduct two progressive raffles but not more than one progressive drawing at each session. Does this mean that if we conduct progressive raffles A and B simultaneously then we can only have a drawing for A on week 1 and a drawing for B on week 2 but that we can sell A and B at the same time?

Rule 8.4.6 (c) - Does this mean that if we want to have a progressive raffle must-go before the jackpot reaches \$15,000 then we must state the amount at the beginning of the progressive series (or can we declare a must-go the week before we have the must-go if we plan to have the must-go when the jackpot reaches, let's say, \$5000)?

Rule 8.4.4 - This rule implies that the ticket requirements for non-member progressive raffle tickets are the same as for non-progressive raffles tickets (over \$1000) as stated in Rule 8.1.4. However there needs to be some differences between progressive raffle and non-progressive raffle tickets:

- (1) A non-progressive raffle drawing is on a certain date but a progressive raffle drawing will take place on multiple dates; therefore the drawing date cannot be printed on a progressive raffle ticket.
- (2) We will have raffle tickets printed in bulk to be cost effective; therefore we will be using the same tickets for multiple progressive series
