Subject: NO INTERNET VOTING

Regarding proposed Rule 16.2.1 (c), I object to any ambiguous wording in the rule that would allow a voter to use email or electronic voting except in ONLY hardship circumstances where a mail-in ballot return or a telephone facsimile return is not available. Such hardship cases must be limited to circumstances 1.) in which the voter cannot expect the paper ballot to be received by the clerk within 8 days after election day with the voter returning, via U.S. mail, his ballot on the same day that he receives it, AND 2.) in which the voter has no telephone facsimile return available.

I would expect such hardship circumstances to be very few, if any.
