Dear Colorado Secretary of State Wayne W. Williams,

I object to the possible amendment to Colorado's Notary Program Rules (8 CCR 1505-11) that would require notaries to take a notary course and pass an exam in order to renew their commissions, specifically:

2.1.3 NO MORE THAN 90 DAYS BEFORE RENEWING A COMMISSION, A NOTARY MUST SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE TRAINING AND PASS THE EXAM ADMINISTERED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

Such an amendment would pose an undue financial and administrative burden and would ultimately serve to line the pockets of the vendor. A notary in good standing should be exempt from this requirement.

Changes to the notary law can be communicated on The Colorado Secretary of State website.

I also would suggest lengthening the notary renewal date to eight years.
