Subject: Comments to help shape Colorado's Election Rules

Thank you for this opportunity to comment.

First, we need to ensure the clear positive identity of each voter for two reasons.

- 1) Only citizens of the United States and a permanent inhabitant of Colorado should vote in Colorado elections. If you live here you need to be a citizen to vote.
- 2) Our voting system should record that the person has voted in real time to prevent this identified person from recording multiple votes using that identity.

Next, please do not allow convicted felons the right to vote until they have been released from prison and the convicted felon goes to the trouble of requesting a restoration of voting rights.

Finally, incarcerated persons awaiting trial should be allowed to vote if they chose.
