Good Morning

We have two concerns regarding the proposed rules:

1. With regard to the Statewide Ballot and Rule 7.12.2, we feel there needs to either be additional rules and or policy with best practices around issuing these ballots in general and especially to confined eligible electors.
2. We feel the intent of HB-1278 was to offer more options for clerk's before they are required to issue a provisional ballot to a voter in the event SCORE loses connectivity. We believe Rule 17.1.2 should reflect this, because as it is written now there is no change from our previous process. We would like to segregate these mail ballots and when SCORE is again live, verify the voter's eligibility and give them vote credit.
