

Re: Election Rules – 8 CCR 1505-1 – Proposed Rules Issued June 15, 2019

Dear Secretary Griswold:

We support the proposed Rules and recommend the following modifications.

Rule 7.1.2 pg 4, line 37-38: We recommend changing the word “MUST” to “MAY”. Allow counties to submit their own signature card form for approval with the Election Plan.

Rule 7.5.1(e), pg 6, line 31-32: We recommend defining the “statute of limitations” or add the statute reference.

Rule 7.5.3, pg 6-7, line 36-39 & 1-2: We recommend allowing the Counties to track these specific voters in SCORE similar to Covered voters.

Rule 7.9.8, pg 10, line 20-24: We recommend more clarification on this rule. Will the Secretary of State provide a way for this to be done consistently across the State?

Rule 17.1.2, pg 16, line 31-33: We recommend separating this sentence to say, “IF THE ELECTOR’S ELIGIBILITY CAN BE DETERMINED, THE JUDGE MUST ISSUE THE VOTER A MAIL BALLOT OR REPLACEMENT BALLOT. THE COUNTY CLERK’S OFFICE MUST ISSUE A MAIL BALLOT OR REPLACEMENT BALLOT IN SCORE IMMEDIATELY.” Assigning vote credit implies voting in person.

We have one recommendation that is not part of the proposed rules.

We recommend defining whether shared drop boxes can be counted as part of the required number of boxes for each participating County.

Thank you for considering our feedback on the proposed rules.
