Hi,

Per my testimony yesterday (8/3/2021), I made the claim that over 1M voters had voter history that predates their registration dates from SCORE. I wanted to take this a step further and see how many people had cast ballots where their voter history predates their registration dates. I'm showing that 948,491 voters have this issue in the SCORE database. Attached is the list of all the voters and the detail that shows their earliest voting data compared against the registration date in SCORE. I'd like to reiterate that this kind of issue is a big deal and makes me doubt the current safeguards in place to protect against voter fraud. As such, I do not agree with any of the rules changes being proposed, especially rule 2.13.2.

In addition, I received all the IP addresses that have *accessed* SCORE since 2018 via a CORA request with the Secretary of State's office and mapped them out (see attached). I filed a complaint with the Office of Attorney General as it appeared that SCORE has been accessed by invalid individuals.
