## Rule # 5.4.3

My question is: Are you attempting to limit the sales of Progressive Pulltabs by requiring us to sell and **PLAY** one game prior to selling a second? This would limit us to playing maybe 3 games instead of 5-7. We would lose every other game while trying to sell the next PT Prog. Game. It will be incredibly tough to sell 480 tickets on the floor while patrons are trying to play Bingo. Our patrons love Firehorse and want to play as many games as possible at each session, especially when the jackpot is high. Also, our jackpot will grow much more slowly as the number of games decrease.

We never play more than one game during a bingo game and we never COMINGLE games. Our callers always report the color and serial number of each game to be played at the start of each game.

Our organization, as well as all others, struggle with having enough volunteers at each session, making floor sales a challenge.

I understand that some groups are selling and playing Prog. Pulltab games ahead of their Bingo session. This seems unfair to ALL of the patrons that arrive just shortly prior to the **designated start time** or have jobs or other commitments that prohibit their arriving early, this is extremely important when the jackpot is high and they do not have an **opportunity to participate.** 

Please consider the above when making your rule making decisions.
